

## Items Prohibited

### From being brought onto the Dounreay site.

- Cameras and other image recording equipment
- Mobile phones with cameras are allowed on site (cameras are not to be used)
- Computer hardware equipment except in support of work activities allowed under controlled conditions
- Children under the age of fourteen years
- Weapons
- Non prescription drugs
- Pets of any kind
- Firearms and ammunition
- Explosives, including fireworks and flares
- Alcoholic liquor
- Radioactive materials
- Chemicals which prove a risk to the health and safety of personnel on site, such as: Corrosives or bleaching substances including mercury and chlorine
- Disabling or incapacitating sprays including mace, pepper spray, tear gas
- Poisons and toxic substances, including rat poison
- Materials capable of spontaneous ignition or combustion
- All substances/processes:
  - Listed in Schedule 2 of the Control of Substances Hazardous to Health 2002
  - Listed in the Environmental Protection (Controls on ozone-depleting Substances) Regulations 2002
  - containing respiratory sensitisers - eg free isocyanates
    - involved in a process which results in the substance being aspirated – e.g. spraying unless with permission from the senior hazardous substances advisor.
- Asbestos (any form)

## Pre-visit

- You will be allocated a visit sponsor who will take the lead responsibility for your visit to Dounreay.
- Personal information request forms will be sent to you for completion, please return them by the deadline provided. Delays in returning these forms could result in your visit being cancelled or a restriction imposed on the facilities you are permitted to visit.
- Please bring photographic ID to site
  - i.e. Passport/Driving Licence, as proof of your identity is required to obtain your site visitors pass.
- Trousers should be worn if you are visiting plant facilities.
- Presentation materials must be e-mailed to your Site Visits Co-ordinator or your visit host in advance of your visit. No portable storage devices are allowed to be used for this purpose.
- If you wish to take your own laptop/tablet to site prior notice would be appreciated. Note you are not allowed to connect to the DSRL network.
- If you require any advice regarding accommodation for your stay please contact your Site Visits Co-ordinator.
- If you are a classified worker, please bring your up-to-date radiation passbook with you.

• Please note: Armed officers patrol in the vicinity of the Dounreay site.

## Travel to Dounreay

- Car – Dounreay is on the A836 (about 10 miles west of Thurso)
- Train – Thurso is served by trains from Wick and Inverness
- Air – Dounreay is approx.
  - 45 minutes from Wick John'O Groat Airport (regular connections from Edinburgh and Aberdeen)
  - 2.5 hours from Inverness Airport by car
- Taxis - Available locally
- Car Hire - Available locally.

## Arrival

### Car

- Turn off the A836 at the Dounreay sign
- Adhere to the 20mph speed limit.
- Keep in left hand lane.
- Park in the visitor's car park, on the left.
- Take note of the car's registration number.
- Follow the green walkway to reception.

### Taxi

- You will be dropped off at Reception.

## Reception

- Your escort will meet you at Reception, where you will be given a safety brief and a visitor's guide leaflet.
- If you have parked in the visitors car park you will be asked for your cars registration number.
- You will be escorted throughout your visit on site.
- Photographic ID must be provided
- A visitor's pass will be issued to you – this must be visible at all times.
- A hi-viz tunic will be issued to you. This must be worn at all times whilst outside.
- Your bag/rucksack will be searched prior to entry onto site.
- Any tablets/laptops will require to be checked by security and necessary paperwork completed.

## On Leaving Site

- You will be escorted to reception.
- Hi-viz tunic and Visitors pass to be returned to reception.
- Depart site following green marked walkways.
